

# Mr. Amigo Association Scholarship



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## **The Mission of Mr. Amigo Association**

To celebrate the shared culture, friendship and family of Brownsville and Matamoros. To enjoy the traditions and history that unite us bringing “The Valley” and “La Frontera” closer together and serving as an example for our two countries.

## **Purpose of this Scholarship**

To assist students who have shown a sincere interest in obtaining a higher education degree by providing financial assistance in the form of a scholarship that can be utilized for educational-expenses such as tuition, books, a laptop, etc. The Mr. Amigo association desires to promote and strengthen relations between the United States and Mexico and enhance awareness and appreciation of Mexican culture and heritage through all its programs, events and activities.

## **Award Amount**

Award amount will vary and can be up to \$1000.00 per award. For 2019-20 Scholarship Mr. Amigo awarded four \$1000.00 scholarships. Scholarship awards vary depending on the amount of money raised for funds annually. Selected recipients will have funds directly distributed to the higher education institution the selected candidate is attending. Mr. Amigo Association will work with the Financial Aid Office of the selected institution to disburse funds related to this award. Selected recipients are required to attend a virtual ceremony tentative scheduled for Saturday, February 27, 2021 at 10 AM.

Selected recipients must contact Mr. Amigo Scholarship Committee and notify them of their selected institution, share their university/college ID Number by August 1, 2021. Recipient must enroll to a college/university within the first fall term after they graduate from high school. Award amount must be applied to educational cost paid to the institution or for other educational needs such as books, education equipment, housing, and meal plans.

## **Eligibility**

- Must be a resident of Cameron County, Texas.
- Must be graduating from high school within the 2020-2021 Academic Year
- Must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA for college courses already completed.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen, Resident Alien or DACA Student.
- Mr. Amigo Board Members and their immediate family members are not eligible for this scholarship.

To ensure impartiality, applicants may not receive assistance from any Mr. Amigo Board Member when completing any part of the application, nor may any Board Member provide a letter of recommendation. Unsuccessful candidates can re-apply for the scholarship annually.

## **Application Period**

The deadline is **February 21, 2021 by midnight**. Any application received after the deadline will not be considered for this scholarship.

## **Application Submittal**

All applications for consideration must be emailed to [mramigoassociation@gmail.com](mailto:mramigoassociation@gmail.com) by the deadline and included one complete application in **.pdf** format ONLY. Include your full name, current high school you are attending, mailing address, contact phone number and email in the body of the email. (Maximum 10 pages, pages must be merged in 1 file attachment, multiple file attachments will result in disqualification, no hardcopies)

## **Scholarship Selection Committee**

The Scholarship Selection Committee shall be comprised of at least three (3) members of the Mr. Amigo Association. Decisions of the Committee shall be final.

## **Notification of Scholarship Awards**

Recipient will be notified of their selection by email and/or by telephone. Scholarship funds will be distributed to the institution. Student must accept the award by end of the day of February 26, 2021.

## **Progress Report**

The Scholarship Selection Committee requests a courtesy letter from the scholarship recipient upon the completion of the first semester, the scholarship is awarded. This information will be used to update The Mr. Amigo Association on the student's status (success).

## **INSTRUCTIONS** – You must include all materials with your application (ONE FILE)

1. \_\_\_Complete and sign the Scholarship Application.
2. \_\_\_a copy of your most current high school or college transcript.
3. \_\_\_Up to three letters of Recommendation from an individual qualified to discuss the type of person you are and any challenges or obstacles you have overcome in order to pursue your education.
4. \_\_\_One to two page (maximum of 350 words) typed personal statement. The statement should include: A brief summary of your background, academic and career goals and a brief statement of your contributions made to the promotion of Mexican heritage and culture in the Rio Grande Valley.
5. \_\_\_One-page resume of your accomplishments, awards, community service, recognitions, and affiliations with organizations.
